Thursday 1st

Assembly elections are now underway in India. JKPS and Mahima Homes ask us to please pray for peace and stability to prevail.

Monday 5th

PiFò Haiti ask us to pray for God's protection as gang violence in Port-au-Prince and the wider area has reached breaking point; no-one feels safe with kidnaps increasing.

Praise God that a church in Kosovo has been trained by the Medical Ambassadors Foundation in 'Community Health Evangelism', and is about to begin outreach.

Saturday 10th

In Moldova the pandemic situation has worsened. Pray for the safety and strength of the Beginning of Life team as they find ways to work with a partial lockdown in place.

Sunday 11th

Please pray for the vacant positions at Mahima Homes in India (image below) to be filled with dedicated and committed staff to serve those impacted by human trafficking.

Monday 12th

The HEAL Africa Chaplaincy follow up project is due to start today in DRC. Please pray for the safety of the two facilitators as they travel, and for it to be a time of good team bonding and capacity building.

Tuesday 13th

Praise God that the Potter's House Business School in Chiquimula, Guatemala, which provides technical and practical learning, has reopened and 52 young people are enrolled.

Wednesday 14th

March was a busy month for JKPS in India. We praise God for the 11 medical clinics they ran, the completion of two water projects, and 20 new believers who were baptised.

Thursday 15th

As restrictions ease in the UK, we pray for our ministry partners who are battling a rise in Covid-19 cases with few resources.



Friday 16th

Widows in Nepal are often left destitute after their husbands death. We give thanks that through Good Friends of Nepal they find support and a hope for the future.

Saturday 17th

Pray for Martin, the ministry leader of Kanal Hayat, who broadcast across Turkey and West Asia. Martin is still suffering from the after affects of Covid-19 three months on.

Sunday 18th

Please pray for God's protection over the areas in Southern Africa where Hope for Africa Mission is working. Many have become hotspots for Covid-19.

Monday 19th

Praise God for the children's centres which the Evangelical Mission for Assistance to Fishermen run in fishing communities in Brazil.



Tuesday 20th

Please pray for our ministry partner in Myanmar, they remain well but are still facing a number of challenges. Access to the internet is intermittent, a curfew is in place, banks are closed and, in some areas, martial law is in place.

Wednesday 21st

We give thanks to the Lord that it is time for another Ministry Meet-up Live event. Today we will be talking live with the Evangelical Church in North Macedonia. Please pray for good internet connections and a blessed time together.

Thursday 22nd

Lift up to the Lord the children who have been selected for the Potter's House sponsorship programme, in Totonicapan, Guatemala. The majority suffer from chronic malnutrition, and some acute malnutrition.

Friday 23rd

Join in praising God with Beginning of Life in Moldova. They were able to have a good month of full activity whilst restrictions were lifted, enabling them to serve many vulnerable families.

Saturday 24th

A food programme has started in two more PIFò Haiti schools (image below), which means all their schools are now able to provide meals to staff and students. An answer to almost ten years of prayer - praise God for his provision!

Sunday 25th

Praise God that the Evangelical Church in North Macedonia, has opened a new church in the city of Radovich. Pray for the small group of believers as they meet together for fellowship and serve their community.

Monday 26th

Please pray for a new couple in Albania, who are going to help lead youth ministries in the church plants. Pray that this it would be a good partnership and a blessing to the youth, helping them to grow in their walk with the Lord.

Tuesday 27th

The situation in DRC remains unstable, please pray for HEAL Africa as they continue to serve amidst such insecurity.



Wednesday 28th

Ask God to guide all those who are being trained in ministry by Hope for Africa Mission, in South Africa. May they be a light to the communities they are preparing to serve.

Thursday 29th
