Thursday 1st

Give thanks for the church planters and outreach workers of Cahaya Suku's ministry in Indonesia. Pray that they will be kept safe as they bring the Gospel into, what are often, dangerous situations.

Friday 2nd

Praise God today for the fantastic examination results announced by GSF Mugunga school recently. Some of the children sponsored via HEAL Africa in DR Congo attend here and care bags were distributed to them.



Sunday 4th

Pray for all the children in our ChildAid schemes across the world, many of which are on their summer breaks. Pray for the children's health and safety during this time.

Monday 5th

Pray for the young people who have recently been baptised in Macedonia, including some Roma. Pray that this will be the start of their new life in Christ.

Tuesday 6th

Please pray for the work of African Inland Church, ministering to thousands of displaced peoples in South Sudan and Uganda. Pray for food security for these refugees.

Wednesday 7th

Please continue to hold the plight of the 700,000 Rohingya refugees in your prayers. Pray for a political solution that will allow them to return home safely to Myanmar. Pray that the continued destruction of villages in Myanmar will cease.

Thursday 8th

Pray for the work of EMAF ministering to fishing communities in remote areas of Brazil. Pray for new disciples in this part of the world.

Friday 9th

Please pray for political stability in Haiti. Recent protests and strikes, have meant that Haiti Christian Schools have struggled to source food and supplies and when they have, prices have been inflated. Currently, they feed 130 children each day, and this is a huge concern for them.

Saturday 10th

Please continue to pray for Serghei, the Chief Executive of Beginning of Life in Moldova, and his wife Galina. Their young son Emil, has recently undergone surgery to remove a brain tumour and they are now facing an uncertain future with more treatment required.

Sunday 11th

Give thanks for the water and sanitation units that have been provided by Potter's House to needy families in Chiquimula, Guatemala, due to the generosity of WorldShare supporters.

Monday 12th

On International Youth Day, pray for the youth work of many of our Ministry Partners. Over the summer, thousands of youngsters take part in their various summer camps, with many dedicating their lives to Christ. Give thanks for all those involved.

Tuesday 13th

Pray for 65 such youngsters who attended a Beginning of Life camp in Moldova last month. Pray that the words that they heard will continue to impact on their hearts, and that they will come to know the Lord.

Wednesday 14th

Give thanks for the new garden built at Haiti Christian schools, giving the children the chance to learn valuable agricultural skills and helping provide nutritious food for them and the local community.
