Pray that the continuing violence in South Sudan, with 4 million people displaced, will come to an end. Pray that the needy can continue to be fed and sheltered by organisations such as our partners, African Inland Church.

Please pray for new ChildAid sponsors to join us this year, to give support to some of the many needy children across the globe waiting for sponsorship.





Wednesday 16th

Thank you Lord for the work of the Urban Centre in Moldova. Pray for them as they reach out to vulnerable young people. These children are the future of the country.

Thursday 17th

Pray for Ester Tepeu, a child in the ChildAid programme at Potter's House in Guatemala. She is suffering with severe anaemia and kidney issues. Pray for complete restoration for her.

Friday 18th

Give thanks for the many thousands of Bibles we have been able to distribute via our Alternative Gift programme over the years. Pray that these will help individuals come to know the Lord as Saviour.
