Saturday 1st

Monday 3rd

Please hold in your prayers the Beginning of Life team in Moldova who serve local teenagers and children. Pray for wisdom and energy in sharing love and hope.

Tuesday 4th

Give thanks to God that Sunshine Cambodia were able to work together with local leaders to provide food packages to 150 vulnerable children last month.

Wednesday 5th

Potter's House in Guatemala ask us to pray that they would continue to represent Jesus well and reflect God's love, so that many more come to know him!

Thursday 6th

Please pray for the Evangelical Mission for Assistance to Fishermen as they begin a new project called 'Come and Share' to reach out to more young people in the area of Ariri, Brazil.

Friday 7th

Thank God for a positive response to our Christmas appeal. Pray that the money raised would make a big difference to refugees in Lebanon and Pakistan, helping them to keep warm during winter and hear the Gospel.

Saturday 8th

Tuesday 11th

Today is the first WorldShare staff team meeting of 2022. Pray for a renewed sense of excitement as we prepare for what God will do in the year ahead, and for our discussions to be productive.

Wednesday 12th

Students undertaking their Ministry Diploma with JKPS in India are transitioning back to offline classes this month and taking exams. Please pray for their protection and safety.

Thursday 13th

At the end of last year, Medical Ambassadors Foundation enjoyed celebrating the 30 years of religious freedom in Albania. Praise God that people can proclaim the name of Jesus without fear of persecution.

Friday 14th

Give thanks to God that PiFò Haiti was able to give their staff a Christmas bonus last month. The money is a HUGE gift for them, and many have already made plans to use it to fix their houses and buy food for family and neighbours.

Saturday 15th

Please pray for healing for Beginning of Life in Moldova's staff members, Yulia and Anna, as they struggle with health problems.

Sunday 16th

The Evangelical Church in North Macedonia is renovating a church building in Skopje and constructing another in Strumica. Pray for the Lord to provide the finances they need.

Monday 17th

Please pray for the final stage of year 1 of HEAL Africa's chaplaincy follow up project in DR Congo which is a vital part of the programme. Pray for no delays or disruptions.

Tuesday 18th

Many of the countries where our ministry partners serve still have limited access to the Covid-19 vaccine. Please pray for the obstacles preventing the rollout of the vaccine to be overcome.

Wednesday 19th

Give thanks that through Beginning of Life's Christmas events in Moldova the light of God's love was shone into the lives of many families who suffer from brokenness and hopelessness.



Thursday 20th

Praise God that Cahayu Suku in Indonesia are seeing relationships restored. One new believer David* had not spoken with his in-laws in many years, but through sharing the Gospel, and seeing the change in his attitude, they have now been reconciled.

Friday 21st

Praise God that ChrisFon has begun working with two further brick kiln communities in Pakistan. Pray for the 40 families being served to soon break free from a life of bonded labour and put their hope in Jesus.

Saturday 22nd

Several of the Kanal Hayat team, who minister across Turkey and West Asia, have been suffering with illness and the impacts of Covid. Please pray that through all of this they would take refuge in the Lord and know his protection.

Sunday 23rd

Please pray for the Lord's provision as Wakisa Ministries in Uganda make plans to construct a health centre, which will help the girls they serve and women in the local community.

Monday 24th

Praise God that leaders from the Evangelical Mission for Assistance to Fishermen in Brazil had an encouraging four-day retreat. They gave feedback on 2021 and planned for the coming years.

Tuesday 25th

Our alliance partner in the USA, Partners International, have a new leadership team. Praise God for their vision and heart for the lost.

Wednesday 26th

Join JKPS as they look back at the past year and praise God for the 150 communities they were able to serve in India through their medical clinics, field visits and Christmas activities.

Thursday 27th

Ask the Lord to give the Hope for Africa Mission team wisdom as they explore the possibility of establishing a school in Zimbabwe, where there are few educational opportunities.

Friday 28th

Praise God for the church leaders being equipped by Africa Inland Church among unreached communities in South Sudan.



Saturday 29th

In Guatemala, Potter's House is seeing the enemy use this time of isolation during the pandemic to split up families and hurt the foundation of their society. Please pray against this spirit of division, and that it would not impact those who Potter's House serve.

Sunday 30th

There is no government funding for inmate meals at the small local jail in La Gonave, Haiti. Prisoners rely on family members to bring them meals, but due to the high price of food, most families have stopped coming. Praise God that PiFò Haiti is able to provide them with rice, beans and oil each month.

Monday 31st

Thank God that 90 teenagers are attending Beginning of Life's Urban Teens outreach club in Moldova every Sunday. As well as getting help with their homework, they have the opportunity to do a Bible study. Pray for God to be at work in their hearts.
