Praise God for the skills the HEAL Africa Chaplains developed in last month's Chaplaincy follow-up training in DRC. They have already put these into action by serving those in their communities impacted by trauma.

Friday 22nd

It has been a busy time for JKPS' youth team in India. Praise God that they were able to host a virtual Youth Camp for 50 children, and a Career Counselling Programme for 36 young people.

Saturday 23rd

Last month we were praying for the MAF team in Albania as they visited Kosovo and North Macedonia to mentor Community Health Evangelism teams. Praise God that the visits were a success!
