**Weds 1st: UK Office**

Pray for our five-day Easter prayer journey starting tomorrow and running until Easter Monday. Follow Jesus and Peter through promise, pressure, silence, hope and commission.

**Thurs 2nd: Guatemala**

Pray for ongoing nutrition and health support through daily lunches, growth monitoring and regular physical activity sessions, asking for strong bodies and minds for every Treasure connected with Potter’s House.

**Fri 3rd: North Macedonia**

Give thanks for the impact of Night to Shine, with a total of 705 participants across three cities. Pray for ECNM as churches follow up with workshops and outreach and ask for provision for the funding still needed.

**Sat 4th: Haiti**

Pray for PiFò Haiti as the garden construction continues, and give thanks that Emerson was able to bring in more supplies from the mainland which is a huge answer to prayer.

**Sun 5th: Easter Day**

This Easter Sunday, as we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, pray that our Easter Appeal would be fruitful and that many encounter His Gospel hope and practical help through our partners where it’s most needed, through the funds raised.

**Mon 6th: Ghana**

Pray for HP Academy to finish the second term well, with good focus, health and attendance for pupils, and encouragement for teachers.

**Tues 7th: Gaza**

Ask for provision and stability in Gaza, where daily life remains difficult. Prices have risen, some items are scarce, and people are waiting to see if more aid will come.

**Weds 8th: India**

Give thanks for 80 JKPS sponsored children and 10 volunteers who joined an educational excursion, and for students who completed their annual exams. Pray for staff and volunteers as they take part in summer camp training in April.

**Thurs 9th: Albania**

Pray for a family in Lamalas, who welcomed a local CHE team and want to learn about Jesus; ask that they receive Christ and for safe attendance at the Easter celebration planned in Vlocisht.

**Fri 10th: DR Congo**

Give thanks with HEAL Africa Chaplaincy for new believers who were baptised after months of discipleship. Pray that they grow in faith and find opportunities to serve.

**Sat 11th: Uganda**

Give thanks for education at Wakisa Ministries, with 41 girls supported and students returning to school with supplies. Pray for those preparing to start university later this year.

**Sun 12th: Guatemala**  
Pray for the Treasures at Potter’s House, for wisdom in their studies, healing from past hurts, and a growing understanding of their God-given value.

Give thanks for joyful learning at Jaden Fleuri, where kindergarten children explored food groups and practised simple cooking before sharing a meal. Pray for PiFò Haiti staff as they teach healthy habits, and for safety and provision for school meals.

**Thurs 16th: Gaza**

Give thanks for God's provision through CMG that enabled Wissam's surgery after years of debilitating illness. Pray for his recovery and for renewed strength to provide for his family.

**Fri 17th: Turkey**

Pray for Kanal Hayat as new programme formats are filmed. Ask that each concept engages more viewers and points many to Jesus, including across Turkey and West Asia.

**Sat 18th: North Macedonia**

Give thanks for workshops that are opening doors with new children and families in Radovish, and pray for Pastor Robert's daily conversations with Ahmed, who is exploring faith and hopes to attend church. Ask for clear next steps and courage.

**Sun 19th: Ghana**

Give thanks for new ChildAid sponsors following our recent appeal; pray for lasting connections and wise, timely provision for students and school needs.

**Mon 20th: India**

Give thanks for JKPS Annual Conferences completed across 17 provinces in February and March, and for a vision casting meeting with Bethel Training Institute alumni to help set future direction. Pray for fruit across churches and projects.

**Tues 21st: Haiti**

Pray for PiFò Haiti's Volunteer Director hoping to travel to La Gonâve in the coming months. Ask for God's provision amid rising flight and insurance costs, the right timing and that the team there be encouraged.

**Weds 22nd: Moldova**

Thank God for growing unity across BOL's Urban programmes, where shared activities and group challenges connect generations and social groups. Pray that God builds one united, loving community.

**Thurs 23rd: South Asia**

Give thanks for a successful inter-school sports and games event at High Priest Academy, and for HPA athletes who performed well. Also, give thanks that HPA pupils were able to take part in an inter-school spelling bee; pray for steady progress in literacy.

Pray for the new issue of Window coming out toward the end of this week. Ask for the Lord to use every story to deepen prayer, engagement and generous support for our partners.

**Weds 29th: Uganda**
