Mon 1st: Gaza

Praise God for the 9,000 hot meals provided by Christian Mission to Gaza in October and for the ongoing delivery of clean drinking water to families in urgent need. Pray that these efforts will continue to bring relief and hope.

Tues 2nd: DR Congo

Ask God to strengthen HEAL Africa's staff and partners as they serve communities amid ongoing violence and instability, and to bring peace to the region.



Weds 3rd: Macedonia

Lift up ECNM's humanitarian ministry in Skopje. Pray for donors and partners to help them serve more families in need, and that this practical support opens doors for the gospel and brings hope.

Thurs 4th: Pakistan

Please pray for our CEO Andrew and trustee Mussarat, as they travel to Pakistan from the 3rd – 8th December for a ministry trip. Pray for wisdom and protection during the trip.

Fri 5th: Uganda

Give thanks for 20 years of Wakisa Ministries and pray for today's anniversary celebrations. Ask God to bless the leadership transition as Joyce becomes director and Vivian retires, and for unity among staff during this new season.

Sat 6th: Turkey

Weds 10th: Guatemala

Pray for wisdom for the new Potter's House staff member as they begin working with 4th–9th graders. Ask God to bless all staff with love and a servant heart.

Thurs 11th: India

Give thanks for the completed Discipleship modules at JKPS and for the faithful service of retiring Bible professor Sumanta, after 36 years. Pray for students sitting exams today and for new enrolments next year.

Fri 12th: Albania

Give thanks for the two couples who have opened their hearts to Jesus through MAF's ministry and pray that they will grow strong in faith as they attend church regularly.

Sat 13th: DR Congo

Pray for MAF's Christmas celebrations across 5 villages in Albania. Give thanks that the children's programme and Advent readings are ready and ask for wisdom as the adult celebration is planned. Pray that all these events will clearly point people to Jesus.

Mon 22nd: Myanmar

Pray for God's provision for Christmas gifts for the children at Hope Orphanage in Myanmar and for a bicycle to help with daily transport and errands. Also, pray for the upcoming two-day pre-Christmas programme at church to share the Good News with unbelievers.

Tues 23rd: UK
