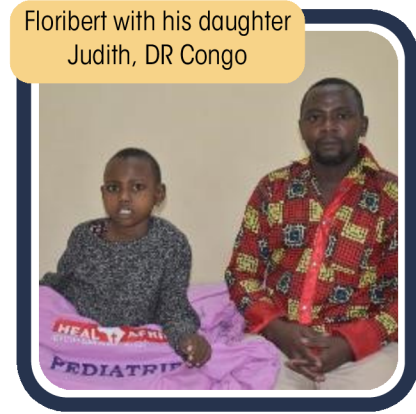
Monday 10th
