Sun 1st: Guatemala

Praise God for His kindness in 2025 and for the start of Potter’s House’s 40th-anniversary year. Ask for wisdom in planning and guidance across their development programmes.

Mon 2nd: DR Congo

Give thanks for new clinical capacity at HEAL Africa in DR Congo: two surgical residents have passed general surgery exams, and a former resident will return as the hospital’s first paediatric surgeon; pray their skills bless many children.

Tues 3rd: North Macedonia

Give thanks for practical winter help through ECNM - firewood and food packages for vulnerable families and pray for God’s provision for the 2026 budget as costs rise.

Weds 4th: Haiti

Praise God for the new opportunities PiFò Haiti has had to support other organisations on the island with translation and accounting. This work helps local ministries continue serving their communities and ensures their staff can remain employed.

Thurs 5th: Myanmar

Praise God for the eleven children who received academic excellence awards last year. Pray that God continues to help all the children for their final examinations.

Fri 6th: Turkey

Pray for Kanal Hayat’s street outreach teams in Turkey, thanking God for those who recently prayed to receive Jesus. Ask for continued boldness and protection as they share the Gospel.

Sat 7th: Gaza

Thank God that CMG recently provided more than 850 meals for Christian families and surrounding communities in Gaza, including hot meals and meat for families in camps who had gone months without it. Pray for steady provision so parents and children continue to receive nourishing food.

Sun 8th: India

Praise God for JKPS’s Annual Members Conference across four provinces in India, the launch of an animal husbandry project, and God’s protection over staff, volunteers and families; pray for wisdom to steward these initiatives well.

Mon 9th: Albania

Give thanks that the Microbusiness Fund with MAF reached its goal (\$5,025). Pray for wise selection, training and follow-up so small enterprises become stable livelihoods and help families remain together.

Tues 10th: Ghana

Ask God to provide funds for additional classrooms at HPA as enrolment rises. Pray for smooth planning and building so lessons continue with minimal disruption.

Weds 11th: Uganda

Pray that Wakisa Ministries can secure a larger van and an ambulance. Reliable transport is essential for hospital visits, emergency care, and daily needs of the girls.

Thurs 12th: Moldova

Praise God for the INTRIGA innovative programme at Beginning of Life, where single mothers and Ukrainian refugees have been active in church life and Sunday services. Pray that a mindset of initiative, innovation and investment-oriented thinking will take root and bear lasting fruit.

Fri 13th: South Asia

Give thanks for the ordination of Peter* in a network church through our partner in South Asia. Pray that mentoring and coaching will shape his first steps in ministry with humility, wisdom and courage.

Give thanks that the Youth Camp for young adults in JKPS’s child sponsorship programme was held successfully. Pray that commitments made will take root and grow.

Sun 15th: Albania

Pray for Nari and his wife, Pajtesa, as they grow in faith and service with Medical Ambassadors Foundation. Ask for maturity and courage as Nari helps with men's meetings and preaching, and as Pajtesa serves among women in their village.

Mon 16th: Myanmar

Give thanks for God's protection and faithful provision over the children and staff at Word of Hope Orphanage, and for the good health they have enjoyed. Please also pray that the children have a meaningful and enjoyable visit to the Space Museum, and that it inspires joy and curiosity.

Tues 17th: Turkey

Give thanks that Kanal Hayat has many testimonies lined up to film in the coming weeks. Pray for clear storytelling, safe shoots and for each story to point viewers to Jesus.

Weds 18th: North Macedonia

Ask the Lord to provide the right new pastor at the Evangelical Church in Kochani as Pastor Venco steps down after 30 years of service. Pray also for Venco after he was attacked outside a service and needed stitches. Give thanks he is recovering and pray for the young man involved.

Thurs 19th: Uganda

Give thanks for God's protection over the girls at Wakisa Ministries. Several have recently experienced safe deliveries, and some have also been resettled with their families. Pray that these new beginnings bring peace, stability, and continued support for both the girls and their babies.

Fri 20th: Ghana

Pray for High Priest Academy as inter-district competitions and sports take place this month. Ask for training sessions and competition days to be safe, disciplined and a good witness for the school.

Sat 21st: Haiti

Thank God for the travel options that have recently opened up between the island and the mainland for PiFò Haiti. They are an answer to prayer despite being more costly.

Sun 22nd: Guatemala

Give thanks for recent Holiday Bible Clubs and Family Festivals through Potter's House in Chiquimula, Guatemala. Children and parents heard the gospel; 71 children accepted Jesus into their hearts as well as 13 mothers and three young women got baptised.

Mon 23rd: South Asia

Thank God for recent Bible distribution with local leaders through our partner in South Asia. Pray that those who received God's Word will read it, understand it and grow as disciples.

Tues 24th: UK Office

Pray for Andrew and Clare as they travel today to visit Potter's House in Guatemala. Ask for safety, good health, and a positive and productive time as they visit all three community centres, meet staff and Treasures.

Weds 25th: Gaza

Praise God that CMG has begun assisting 60 families in the neighbourhood where Pastor Hanna grew up, providing basic needs and blankets during the cold weather. Pray that these families experience warmth, dignity and hope as support continues.

Pray for the local outreach team connected with MAF as they reorganise and receive refresher training after two members stepped back. Ask that the team restarts their project this month with unity and perseverance.

Sat 28th: DR Congo

Pray for peace, protection and food security for communities in and around Goma and across eastern DR Congo, and for God's sustaining care over HEAL Africa's staff and patients in the year ahead.
