Thurs 1st: UK

Pray as we start our three-day New Year devotional today, 'Building Faith for a Promised Future'. Ask God to deepen trust in his promises as we walk, build and serve. Start here: worldshare.org.uk/newyear

Fri 2nd: Moldova

Give thanks that BOL marked Christmas through Urban Kids sessions with gingerbread biscuits, crafts and family gifts, and through Ukrainian refugee groups sewing toys and sharing the Christmas story in care homes and homes for people with disabilities.



Sat 3rd: North Macedonia

Praise God for children's outreach: Roma family gatherings in Kavadarci where children's classes are beginning at home, EC Probishtip restarting children's classes, and creative workshops at EC Radovich where children received New Testaments. Pray that faith will take root in these homes.

Sun 4th: Haiti

Praise God that staff at PiFò Haiti received their annual Christmas bonus. Pray for sustained provision through 2026.

Mon 5th: Myanmar

Give thanks that Hope Orphanage blessed the children with Christmas gifts and shared the Good News through their Christmas outreach.

Tues 6th: Turkey

Give thanks that through Kanal Hayat many viewers came to faith last year and were connected with local Christian family. Pray they will be strengthened through faithful follow-up.

Wed 7th: Gaza

Give thanks that CMG delivered Christmas gifts and winter clothing to families despite tough conditions. Pray that ongoing winter support will bring warmth and hope through the colder weeks.

Thurs 8th: India

Pray for the Youth Camp for young adults in the child sponsorship programme with JKPS, taking place 8th to 11th January 2026. Ask for safety, unity and lasting spiritual growth.

Fri 9th: UK

Pray for WorldShare as the team gathers today for a strategy day to review 2025 and plan for the rest of this year; ask God for unity, wise priorities and Spirit-led focus that serves partners and supporters well.

Sat 10th: Ghana

Pray for High Priest Academy throughout 2026; for excellence across teaching and learning, examinations, sports, cultural activities and quizzes, and that the school's district standing continues to build on last year's progress.

Sun 11th: Uganda

Thank God for the safe deliveries and health education classes at Wakisa Ministries. Pray for continued protection for mothers and babies, and for wisdom for staff as they teach life skills.

Mon 12th: Moldova

Praise God that BOL reaches 150 children weekly through school based activities, with one class visiting each week. Pray these visits will nurture character and hope.

Tues 13th: DR Congo

Give thanks that HEAL Africa has kept its Goma hospital caring for the wounded and the community through ongoing conflict and reduced salaries; pray God strengthens and sustains the team day to day.

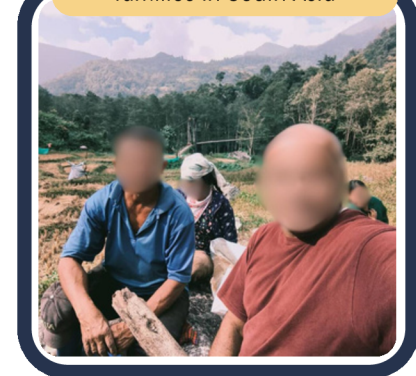
Wed 14th: India

Give thanks that JKPS celebrated Christmas at four child sponsorship programme centres, with gifts for beneficiaries, and across churches and house fellowships.

Thurs 15th: South Asia

Give thanks that a new partner in South Asia shared the Gospel through their outreach, and that recent home visits among farming families opened doors for relationship. Pray the Holy Spirit continues to draw many to Christ in the months ahead.

Fri 16th: Haiti

Give thanks that Emerson has returned to full capacity with PiFò Haiti. Pray for grace, stability and ongoing pastoral support for him and his family as they adjust to a new normal.

Sat 17th: Turkey

Praise God for seekers like Fatih, Emrah and Ali whose faith has grown through Kanal Hayat, with bold witness and baptism preparation. Pray for courage, family support and wise mentors in their walk.

Sun 18th: North Macedonia

Give thanks for the prison ministry in Shtip, where Bibles were shared and good conversations held with inmates. Pray for lives to be transformed and hope to spread among prisoners.

Mon 19th: Guatemala

Pray for God's provision of the finances needed in 2026 so Potter's House can continue supporting education and wider programmes across every region.

Tue 20th: Moldova

Thank God for BOL's session last month with 48 teachers from a city lyceum on protecting children from bullying and violence. Pray that safeguarding practice strengthens across local schools and classrooms.

Weds 21st: DR Congo

Pray for provision and access to care at HEAL Africa: with banks closed and commerce diminished, many seek treatment only when desperate; ask God to supply medicines, equipment and funds so the poor and displaced can be served.

Thurs 22nd: Myanmar

Pray that, despite last year's earthquake-related delays and the rise in material costs, Word of Hope Orphanage will be able to start the new three storey girls' dormitory early this year, with steady provision and clear next steps.

Fri 23rd: South Asia

Pray for church planting efforts through our new partner in South Asia - asking God to establish worshipping communities in the villages they visit, and to grow mature local disciples.

Sat 24th: North Macedonia

Thank God for youth engagement across ECNM, including the one-day youth seminar at EC Veles with around 50 participants. Pray for faithful young disciples and emerging leaders.

Sun 25th: UK

Pray for CEO Andrew as he visits and shares today at Emmanuel Fellowship in Loxwood near Billingshurst; ask God to guide his message, bless conversations, and open a door for ongoing prayerful connection.

Mon 26th: Haiti

Give thanks that the PiFò Haiti team feel the prayers and are grateful for a global community of supporters. Pray that supporters will not be dismayed by "lost cause" narratives but will persevere in prayer and partnership, and that Haitians entering the New Year will know comfort, resilience and renewed hope.

Tues 27th: Albania

Give thanks that MAF launched the Microbusiness Fund to counter hardship and emigration. Pray that the year-end target of \$5,000 went well, and that January approvals help families stay, preserve skills and combat falling populations.

Weds 28th: Guatemala

Pray for a strong start to the new term for all Treasures at Potter's House. As they return this month, ask for strength, attendance, motivation and good progress across their training and education.

Thurs 29th: Ghana

Praise God for the new classroom furniture at High Priest Academy, enabling better seating and learning; give thanks for our faithful supporters who made this possible, and pray God's care over them this year.

Fri 30th: India

Thank God that JKPS students sat their Seekers and Believers exam in December. Pray for the Bible Training Institute as they schedule all four modules for 2026, with wise planning and committed participation.

Sat 31st: Turkey

Praise God for long-term fruit like Kemal's journey from seeker to shepherd, now guiding others. Pray for leaders emerging through Kanal Hayat to be equipped to care for new believers and seekers well.
