Give thanks that nine new students have started their first year at Hope Bible College in Myanmar. Please pray that as they follow God's call on their lives, they will be encouraged and strengthened in their faith.

Sunday 21st

Please pray for the interviews taking place this week for a new Finance Officer to join the WorldShare staff team. Pray that God will provide the right person, with suitable skills and experience, to fulfil the role.

Monday 22nd

80% of the population of Gaza depend on aid for food and less than 10% of the water is fit to drink. Ask God that Christian Mission to Gaza will be able to provide aid to many families while sharing the hope of Jesus.

Tuesday 23rd

Please continue to pray for PiFò Haiti and the extreme food crisis they are facing on La Gonâve. The island has been identified as one of the most critical areas in Haiti for food insecurity. They can't keep up with the demand of over 100,000 inhabitants cut off from the mainland and its supplies.

Wednesday 24th

Please pray for a group of girls in Wakisa Ministries in Uganda who have had traumatic births, that they will receive the peace and joy that comes from God alone. Pray for wisdom for their counsellor as she helps them through this time.

Thursday 25th

Praise God that eight new students have enrolled for the next academic session of the one-year Certificate in Ministry Course run by JKPS in India. Please pray that they would quickly adapt to the new environment.

Friday 26th

Thank God that through funds from WorldShare, HEAL Africa has been able to launch the first phase of their Chaplaincy project this month - training for Military Chaplains and Pastors in Beni and Butembo.

Saturday 27th

Please ask God to provide Kanak Hayat with suitable applicants to fill their two staff vacancies. They need to add a coordinator and a production assistant to their ministry team as their work grows in Turkey and West Asia.
