Mon 1st: Guatemala

Pray for Potter’s House and for Pedro, who is carrying responsibility for supporting his younger sister and is growing tired. Ask God to provide work for him and give him strength and courage to keep going.

Tues 2nd: India

Give thanks with JKPS for the successful Summer Camp, which brought together 400 beneficiaries from the Sponsorship Programme. Pray that the children and young people who took part will continue to grow in faith, confidence and hope.

Weds 3rd: North Macedonia

Pray for the young people reached through ECNM events in Shtip and Gevgelija. Ask God to draw the young people closer to Himself and raise up a generation that is hungry for more of Him.

Thurs 4th: Haiti

Give thanks with PIFò Haiti that the main parts for the garden solar system arrived safely, and that a pickup truck has been provided to help transport staff and supplies during Wendy’s visit. Pray for God’s protection while she is there and safe travel home next week.

Fri 5th: Turkey

Pray that God will provide the new workers needed to help meet the growing demands of Kanal Hayat’s ministry.

Sat 6th: DR Congo

Pray that WorldShare’s Emergency Ebola Appeal for HEAL Africa will prompt a swift and generous response, helping meet the added costs of protective measures, and emergency support.

Sun 7th: Gaza

Pray for CMG as they continue supporting believers in Gaza, including seven families now being helped with rent and 14 families still sheltering at the church.

Mon 8th: South Asia

Pray for Mustard Seed Ministries as rising costs and difficult rainy season travel make ministry harder. Ask God to provide for practical needs and protect the pastor planning an upcoming visit.

Tues 9th: Albania

Pray for MAF as Holiday Bible Clubs take place in June and July in Vashtemi and Vlocisht, that many children will receive God’s Word into their hearts. Pray too for the wider planning for summer ministry.

Weds 10th: Ghana

Pray for HP Academy, as the school prepares to take part in the district cultural festival. Ask God to help pupils do well and use the event to build confidence and unity across the school community.

Thurs 11th: Guatemala

Pray for Potter’s House as the heat is affecting both learning and health, making it harder for students to focus in class and causing some children and clinic patients to stay away.

Fri 12th: Moldova

Give thanks with Beginning of Life for the Studio of Innovative Leadership, with 24 students from 13 countries. Pray that God will bless these future leaders.

Sat 13th: UK Office

Pray for CEO Andrew as he visits St Luke’s, Cheltenham, for their Mission Partners celebration tomorrow. Give thanks for their faithful partnership with WorldShare and pray for encouraging conversations and deepened relationships with those committed to praying for our work.

Sun 14th: Myanmar

Pray for Word of Hope Orphanage as the children prepare for school admissions and ask God to provide funds for uniforms and other educational needs.

Mon 15th: Uganda
