**Sun 1st: Guatemala**

Please pray for Potter’s House’s *Base Camp*. Ask for safe travel for all, a harmonious time together, and a deeper understanding of the work in the Community Centres, especially as Andrew and Clare from WorldShare are in country until 5<sup>th</sup> March.

**Mon 2nd: South Asia**

Thank God for the recent youth conference where more than 500 young people gathered. Pray that new commitments, healings and restored lives will grow into lasting discipleship and faithful service in local churches.



**Tues 3rd: North Macedonia**

Please pray that ECNM’s new cultural centre will be a bridge between Macedonians and Albanians. Ask the Lord to bless relationships with neighbours from Muslim backgrounds and to open doors for the Gospel.

**Weds 4th: Haiti**

Thank God that the island of La Gonâve’s hospital opened its first blood bank, replacing direct transfusions. Pray that this service stays well supplied and well-staffed.

**Thurs 5th: Myanmar**

Give thanks for the staff at Word of Hope Orphanage. Pray for stamina, unity, and refreshed hearts as they serve the children.

**Fri 6th: Turkey**

Give thanks for student Farid\*, who found a NT Bible online, connected with Kanal Hayat’s team, came to faith, and later saw a family member believe as well; they now serve actively in church. Pray for ongoing growth and for another family member who is exploring faith.

**Sat 7th: Gaza**

Pray for CMG supported families after severe storms flooded and tore many tents. Ask God to provide safer shelter, warm clothing, and swift help where the damage is worst.

**Sun 8th: India**

Please pray for JKPS as they carry out this month’s plans: staff meetings, a members’ conference, field visits, a medical clinic, training sessions, and forming a new company to grow the Social Enterprise Unit. Ask for integrity, clarity and impact.

**Mon 9th: Albania**

Give thanks for children’s celebrations supported by MAF’s network, including 120 children participating in Vlocisht and hearing the Gospel.

**Tues 10th: DR Congo**

Ask God to shield women and girls and to equip HEAL Africa to address online facilitated abuse, improving digital safety awareness so that on and offline spaces become safer.

**Weds 11th: Uganda**

Thank God that Wakisa Ministries’ maternity centre is now officially licensed (27 January 2026). Pray for wisdom as services scale up and for good awareness in surrounding communities.

**Thurs 12th: Moldova**

Praise God that BOL completed the mid-year lessons on schedule. Pray for strength, perseverance and fruit as the team and participants continue through the academic year.

**Fri 13th: South Asia**

Pray for the April Discipleship Training. Ask for smooth permissions, logistics and safe travel for all. May this gathering build leadership development across borders and guide future church planting among least reached communities.

**Sat 14th: UK Office**

Please pray for CEO Andrew at the Filling Station event tonight in Rotherham. Ask for clear, Christ-centred communication, receptive hearts, fruitful conversations that lead to ongoing prayer and support, and safe travel.

**Sun 15th: Albania**

Give thanks with MAF for the local CHE team, re-formed and Spirit-led, as they enter a new village, Lumalas. Pray that the Lord leads them to people whose hearts are prepared and open to the Gospel.

**Mon 16th: Gaza**

Ask God to provide for 43 Christian families who have no homes to return to, and for CMG’s planned rent assistance while longer term solutions are found.

**Tues 17th: Turkey**

Pray that God will lead the Kanal Hayat team to more people willing to share their stories. Ask for discernment, protection and sensitivity as they listen and capture testimonies.

**Weds 18th: Guatemala**

Thank God for the Agricultural and Livestock Learning Centre run by Potter’s House, where 100+ families are learning to grow crops at home. Current crops include hibiscus, cassava and radish; pray that these gardens strengthen nutrition and income for many homes.

**Thurs 19th: Uganda**

Pray for wisdom and funds for Wakisa Ministries to purchase nearby land, about £26,000, to help resettle mothers who cannot safely return home.

**Fri 20th: Ghana**

Thank God for Cecilia, a cook at HPA, after successful surgery. Pray for a full recovery and strength, and for the kitchen team to stay healthy and keep meals running smoothly for students while she recuperates.

**Sat 21st: Haiti**

Please pray for PiFò Haiti as they respond to a surge in voodoo practices among young people. Last month a 20-year-old was taken to a voodoo priest instead of receiving hospital care, given a mixture that included human remains, and died a week later. Ask the Lord to break deception, turn families toward timely medical help, and draw young people to Jesus.

**Sun 22nd: UK Office**

Please pray for CEO Andrew, as he visits Evesham Baptist Church. Give thanks for their support; ask that relationships deepen, the message is clear, and everyone is encouraged in Christ.

**Mon 23rd: South Asia**

Please pray for the pastors’ training as it reaches the graduation module this month. Ask God to deepen friendships, renew weary hearts and multiply partnerships for the Gospel.

**Tues 24th: North Macedonia**

Give thanks for recent outreach across ECNM churches among Roma and Turkish families and pray for lasting fruit. Ask for good follow up with the 5 new Bible clubs now meeting in Strumica, Monospitovo, Kavadarci, Prilep and Resen.

**Weds 25th: Gaza**

Pray for CMG as they work to secure clean water and safe sanitation. Ask the Lord to stop disease where floodwater mixed with sewage, and to protect people from cholera, acute diarrhoea, viral hepatitis, influenza, pneumonia, and skin infections like impetigo and scabies.

**Thurs 26th: India**

Give thanks for the Bethel Training Institute’s 36th graduation last month as JKPS students were commissioned. Pray for fruitful placements and that each graduate serves with humility and wisdom.

**Fri 27th: Albania**

Pray for MAF and local churches in Korçë as they plan a CHE vision seminar and give thanks for the recent one completed in Bulgaria. Ask for a clear pathway into CHE’s first Training of Trainers and for brothers in Stara Zagora to form a local CHE team.
