## Monday 3rd

Pray for the girls at Wakisa as they return to school for their final term. Ask God to help them excel and grow in faith.

## Wednesday 5th

Thank God for the free surgery and holistic care Uwimana received at HEAL Africa in DR Congo. Pray that her restored health will open doors for reconciliation and a new beginning.

## Thursday 6th

Pray for lasting peace in Gaza following the recent renewal of the ceasefire. Ask God to protect families and bring stability to a region long marked by suffering.

## Friday 7th

Pray for the recent CHE health screenings in Kosovo, where around 500 people were served by MAF. Ask God to bless the relationships formed in these communities.

## Saturday 8th

Pray for God's guidance as Kanal Hayat explores new fundraising ventures. They hope to improve and expand their facilities so they can create more Gospel programmes.

## Sunday 9th

Pray for Andrew as he visits Church on the Green near Bradford today. Ask that his time with the church would be uplifting and that he can clearly share how God is working through WorldShare's partners.

## Monday 10th

Thank God for the Health Centre in Guatemala City, which has provided 25,000 services in two years. Pray for continued resources so every Potter's House programme in Guatemala can meet community needs.

## Tuesday 11th

Thank God that schools on La Gonâve were able to reopen in October. Pray for teachers and students as they continue learning in the midst of Haiti's instability and hardship.

## Wednesday 12th

Please pray for our Charity Gifts ad campaign launching this week, that it reaches many people and inspires generous giving to help those in need.

## Thursday 13th

Thank God for the children in the child sponsorship programme at JKPS in India. Many have recently completed their Annual Bible Exam, and others are now preparing for their term-end school exams. Pray that they will study well and grow in both knowledge and faith.

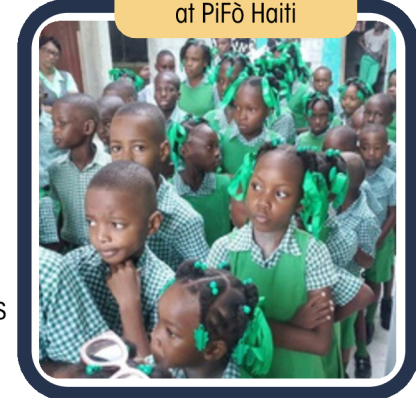
## Friday 14th

### Monday 17th

Please pray for ChrisFon's outreach to Pashtun communities in Pakistan. Ask that God will open hearts and lead many to encounter His love and truth.

### Tuesday 18th

Please pray for Emerson, the manager at PiFò Haiti, as he navigates a family situation. Ask that God will intercede on his behalf and protect him from spiritual attack.

### Wednesday 19th

Pray for the new Discipleship Course at the International Church in Skopje, part of ECNM. Ask that participants will grow in faith and become strong witnesses for Christ.

### Thursday 20th

Please pray for the Community Transformation programme at JKPS in India. The Seekers, Believers, and Discipleship modules are progressing well, with new interviews taking place this month to induct more students. Ask for God's guidance and lasting impact through these courses.

### Friday 21st

Pray for the elders and the church plants in three villages near Korça, Albania, where MAF is using Community Health Evangelism to share the gospel. Ask God to grow these communities in faith and unity, and to equip the elders to lead well.

### Saturday 22nd

Thank God for His constant protection and faithful provision for the children and staff at Hope Orphanage in Myanmar. Praise Him for the joyful outing they recently enjoyed and for the successful two-day salvation seminar.

### Sunday 23rd

Ask God to provide Bibles for those reached through Living Word of Faith's ministry in Ghana, so they can grow in their faith and understanding of God's Word.

### Monday 24th

Pray for the women who attended the recent seminar in Shtip and for those preparing for the National Women's Conference. Ask that God will encourage and equip them in their faith.

### Tuesday 25th

Pray for wisdom and discernment as Christian Mission to Gaza continues to assess the most urgent needs. Ask God to guide their team as they respond with compassion and clarity in a constantly changing situation, and that their faithful presence through Gaza Baptist Church would bring comfort and hope to those who feel forgotten.

### Wednesday 26th

Praise God for the recent rainfall that has helped agriculture projects at PiFò Haiti. Pray that crops will thrive and provide food for families, even as poor roads make travel difficult.

### Thursday 27th

Praise God for the 145 Ukrainian refugees supported by Beginning of Life in Moldova. Pray that the new initiative focusing on Innovation, Investment, and Initiative will help them rebuild their lives with dignity and faith.

### Friday 28th

Give thanks for nine Treasures graduating from the Education Programme in Guatemala this year. Pray for God's guidance as they take their next steps, and for Treasures on Missions as they prepare to lead a Holiday Bible Club this November.

### Saturday 29th

Give thanks for five girls who have just started university through Wakisa's support. Pray for wisdom and perseverance in their studies.

### Sunday 30th

Pray for Andrew as he speaks at Enniskillen Presbyterian Church and Seagoe Parish Church in Northern Ireland today. Ask that these visits would strengthen relationships and stir hearts to partner in prayer and support for vulnerable communities globally.
