Tues 1st: Moldova

Give thanks with Beginning of Life for five summer day programmes where teenagers enjoyed cooking, sports and other activities, while Superbook opened conversations about Bible stories and God’s truth. Pray these truths take root and relationships grow.

Weds 2nd: Guatemala

Pray for Potter’s House as they plan their Children’s Day celebration, bringing nearly 200 Treasures from all three regions together in one location for the first time. Ask God to provide the funds needed and enable everyone to travel safely.



Thurs 3rd: UK Office

Pray for CEO Andrew as he prepares to complete his skydive tomorrow. Ask God for safe conditions and protection and pray that his efforts will inspire generous support for WorldShare.

Fri 4th: Haiti

Give thanks that schools are due to reopen on time on the 7th, after violence delayed the start until October in recent years. Pray for a safe and settled return for pupils, teachers and families.

Sat 5th: Türkiye

Pray for Kanal Hayat during a period of restructuring, as some team members leave and others join. Ask God to guide each decision with wisdom and open new doors for the ministry’s fundraising.

Sun 6th: India

Give thanks with JKPS for the Drawing Competition held across all four Sponsorship Programme centres. Pray that activities like this will continue to develop the children’s creativity, confidence & skills.

Mon 7th: Myanmar

Give thanks with Word of Hope Orphanage that one student has passed her final secondary school examination. Pray for God’s guidance as she considers her next steps and future opportunities.

Tues 8th: South Asia

Give thanks for Samuel* and his wife, who are now attending church together after believers supported them through a painful bereavement. Pray they will be rooted in Christ and cared for through church.

Weds 9th: Albania

Give thanks with MAF for three 14-year-old Roma girls who were able to attend a Christian camp for the first time after their parents gave permission. Praise God that they described it as the most beautiful time of their lives and pray it will have a lasting impact.

Give thanks with ECNM for 5,000 Turkish copies of John’s Gospel and 200 large-print Albanian Bibles received for Rilinda’s ministry. Pray that these, and the New Testaments already distributed, will reach people seeking God and transform lives.

Fri 11th: Moldova

Pray for BOL as the new academic year begins across Urban Kids, Urban Teens and Urban PAS. Ask God for team unity, wisdom, and a fruitful start with the children and families who join.

Sat 12th: UK Office

Pray for Andrew as he visits St Matthias, Torquay, tomorrow. Give thanks for the church’s many years of faithful and generous support and pray for good conversations.

Sun 13th: Guatemala

Give thanks for four Treasures who decided to follow Jesus, two who renewed their faith, and four who put Christian values into practice by serving other Treasures. Pray that each will grow in Christ and continue living out their faith.

Mon 14th: Uganda

Pray for Wakisa Ministries’ planned medical camp, which will raise awareness of the maternity centre among the surrounding community. Ask God to guide the preparations and help mothers to learn about and access the care available.

Tues 15th: Gaza

Thank God for believers who are finding peace and resilience through Scripture amid trauma and pray for CMG as they walk with seekers and strengthen the church through the Word.

Fri 18th: South Asia

Pray for Maya*, a boarding-school student supported through Mustard Seed Ministries because her family cannot meet all her education and living costs. Ask God to provide for her needs and help her grow in faith through the care she receives during school holidays.

Sat 19th: Ghana

Sun 20th: Türkiye

Give thanks that Kanal Hayat is seeing increased viewer interaction with videos exploring deep questions about life, faith, Christianity and Islam. Pray for wisdom as the team creates content, including a new podcast-style testimony format, helping people discover Jesus through real stories.

Mon 21st: Haiti

Give thanks that PiFò Haiti's solar system removes the need for diesel to pump water. With fuel over £5 per gallon and 40% of people living on around £1.50 a day, praise God for these savings and pray for travel provisions to and from the garden.

Tues 22nd: Albania

Pray for around 40 evangelistic family visits planned by MAF this month. Ask God to prepare hearts, guide each conversation and give many families an opportunity to hear and respond to the Gospel.

Weds 23rd: India

Give thanks with JKPS for the successful August training programme, which equipped 35 leaders and led to teaching across 26 fellowships. Pray that those trained will faithfully apply and share what they have learnt.

Thurs 24th: South Asia

Give thanks with Mustard Seed Ministries for 15 pastors who completed 18 months of training. Pray that the friendships formed between younger and more experienced pastors will bring ongoing encouragement, shared learning and support.

Fri 25th: Guatemala

Give thanks for an inspiring afternoon when 43 primary-school Treasures from Potter's House evangelised children in a local park, sharing Bible verses learnt during devotionals and snacks they had prepared. Pray for those they met and that the Treasures will keep sharing their faith.

Sat 26th: Myanmar

Give thanks that the unfinished girls' dormitory provided a safe place for the children to sleep and cook when the old kitchen and other areas flooded at Hope Orphanage. Pray for swift progress and continued provision so this important building can be completed soon.

Sun 27th: North Macedonia

Give thanks for opportunities to share the Gospel in Radovish through a local football tournament, free coffee and conversations. Pray for Pastor Robert as he reaches miners, prisoners and people struggling with drug, alcohol and gambling addictions, that God's Word will bring hope and transformation.

Mon 28th: Albania

Pray for wisdom for staff and counsellors as they guide other girls through difficult family reconciliations.

Pray for children from BOL's Toddler Studio as they begin kindergarten. Ask God to help them adapt well, feel safe and confident, and use the skills they developed over the summer.
